



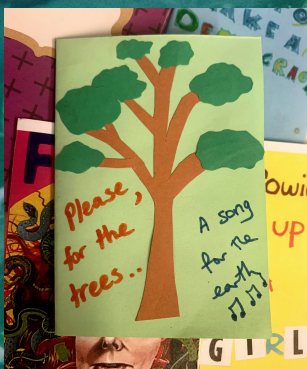
SUSTAINABLE CHANGE MAKERS

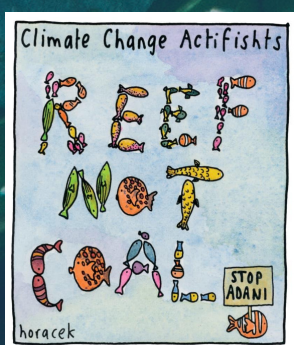
MAKE-A-ZINE
