# COVID-19 SAFETY PLAN OVERVIEW

The health and safety of our staff and visitors is of the utmost importance here at The Museum of Australian Democracy at Old Parliament House (MoAD). That means that we are doing things a little different than usual. Here's what MoAD is doing to keep you safe:



Ticketed entry has been introduced to ensure the number of people within the museum remains safe. It is essential that when you arrive you check in using the Check In CBR app.



Face masks are mandatory for staff and visitors while inside the museum.



We are supporting safe physical distancing using separate entry and exit points and limiting the number of visitors allowed in the museum at any one time.



We have increased the frequency of cleaning in the museum. This is focused around areas with high touch points. Hand sanitiser is available throughout the museum for visitors and staff to use to assist with maintaining good personal hygiene.



A plan is in place to manage staff and visitors who are unwell. Staff have been told to stay home if they are feeling unwell, while visitors are requested to postpone their visit.
